Starting School? If you have a child born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020, then now is the time to apply for a place at a primary school for admission from September 2024 onwards. If your child has been baptised and you are applying for a Catholic school, you must also provide a copy of the baptism certificate to the school. Please ensure you apply by the closing date of 15th January 2024.
