Interfaith Week 11th to 18th November – An evening of interfaith exploration will be held in the Apostle room of Clifton Cathedral on Wednesday 14th November. It will be chaired by Professor Gavin D'Costa with contributions from Professor Sajjad Rizvi, University of Exeter, a Muslim specialist on Islamic philosophy and interfaith dialogue, Dr Alexander Goldberg, a Jewish international consultant on intercultural, interfaith and community relations, and Jacob Fareed Imam, a Catholic who is undertaking a doctorate at Oxford investigating the Islamic roots of the Protestant Reformation. The evening will begin at 7.15pm; refreshments will be available from 6.30pm. All are most welcome.

November 27th - Evening Prayer at the Cathedral 7.00pm – resources for the Year of Prayer.
