Bishop Declan will be coming to St Anthony of Padua for a visitation next Sunday, 18th February; he will preside at Mass.

Lent Course - Tuesdays from 20th February to 19th March: Pope Francis has named 2024 the Year of Prayer, a year spent in preparation for the 2025 Jubilee Year. He has called on all Catholics to spend this year deepening their prayer lives. Our Lent Course this year is "We Dare to Say" a Clifton Diocese resource exploring the prayer our Saviour gave us, The Our Father. We will be running two Lent groups every Tuesday from 20th February to 19th March; 10.30 am in the Hall, and 7.00 pm at 16, Sherwood Avenue. All welcome – please sign up on the sheet in the porch.

Liturgy of Reconciliation, Wednesday 21st February: We are delighted that Bishop Declan will visit St Anthony of Padua for one of this year's Diocesan Penitentiary Services. The service will start at 7.00 pm, and there will be priests available to celebrate sacramental reconciliation.
