Starting School? If you have a child born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017, then now is the time to apply for a place at a primary school for admission from September 2021 onwards. You must complete an application form available from the school admissions team of Wiltshire Council. If your child has been baptised and you are applying for a Catholic school, you must also provide a copy of the baptism certificate to the school concerned – contact the school for full details.
