Youth Synod - During October, Pope Francis is holding a synod on Youth, Faith and Vocational Discernment. For the Week 15th to 21st October, our diocese is entering a time of **Focus and Prayer** for young people. The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children has produced postcards so that you can send a message to your MP urging her to vote against a dangerous abortion bill which is coming up in the House of Commons on Tuesday 23rd October. The Bill seeks to decriminalise abortion which would remove any effective legal protection for unborn babies and their mothers in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. Thursday 25th October - St James' Priory, Bristol, is hosting a concert of Early Music from the 16th and 17th Centuries performed by The Minstrel Ensemble on Thursday 25 October at 6.30pm.

November 10th Diocesan Family Day at St Brendan's College – encountering the Lord. On Saturday 10 November we gather at St Brendan's College, Brislington, (10.15am to 3pm) with David Wells who will help us reflect upon *Encounter the Lord*. The day at St Brendan's is set to prepare us for the coming Year of Prayer (beginning the first Sunday of Advent) and introduce us to the resources that will be available to us from the end of November. Interfaith Week 11th to 18th November – An evening of interfaith exploration will be held in the Apostle room of Clifton Cathedral on Wednesday 14th November. It will be chaired by Professor Gavin D'Costa with contributions from Professor Sajjad Rizvi, University of Exeter, a Muslim and a specialist on Islamic philosophy and interfaith dialogue, Dr Alexander Goldberg, a Jew and an international consultant on intercultural, interfaith and community relations, and Jacob Fareed Imam, a Catholic who is currently undertaking a doctorate at Oxford investigating the Islamic roots of the Protestant Reformation. The evening will begin at 7.15pm and refreshments will be available from 6.30pm. All are most welcome.
