Time for Secondary School: If you have a Year 6 child (born between 1st September 2012 and 31st August 2013), then now is the time to apply for their secondary school place for September 2024. To make your application you must complete the secondary transfer application form provided by your home Local Authority (available on the LA website) by 31st October, and if you are applying for a baptised child for any of the Catholic secondary schools listed below*, you should also additionally complete their Supplementary Information Form (available on the school's website) and provide the school with a copy of your child's baptism certificate, also by 31st October.
