It will be chaired by Professor Gavin D'Costa with contributions from Professor Sajjad Rizvi, University of Exeter, a Muslim and a specialist on Islamic philosophy and interfaith dialogue, Dr Alexander Goldberg, a Jew and an international consultant on intercultural, interfaith and community relations, and Jacob Fareed Imam, a Catholic who is currently undertaking a doctorate at Oxford investigating the Islamic roots of the Protestant Reformation. **The evening will begin at 7.15pm** and refreshments will be available from 6.30pm.
