To make your application **you must complete the secondary transfer application form provided by your home Local Authority (available on the LA website) by 31<sup>st</sup> October, and** if you are applying for a baptised child for any of the Catholic secondary schools listed below\*, you should **also** additionally complete their Supplementary Information Form (available on the **school's** website) and provide the school with a copy of your child's baptism certificate, **also by 31<sup>st</sup> October**.
