**Attending Mass from 19<sup>th</sup> July:** The PPC have decided that from 19<sup>th</sup> July the following changes will be made:

There is no longer a requirement to pre-book Mass attendance, but **you must** ensure your name and contact number/details are recorded on the list on entering the church;

Face masks **should** continue to be worn inside the church, and hand sanitising will continue as now; The offertory procession will commence from Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> August; "Please leave a space" cards will be available for those who wish to retain the 1 metre spacing rule:

The 10.00 am Saturday Mass will recommence on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> August.

The one-way system for going to Communion will cease and we revert to Communion starting from the front right hand bench and ending with the front left hand bench- please continue to respect social distancing:
