

**SYNOD 2021 - 2023:** The Pope wants to take the temperature of the Church! He wants to know how all of us, and the lay people especially, are feeling. - 2. What are the obstacles to an active parish life?

3. How is God speaking to us through the voices that are in our midst, or through the voices that we sometimes ignore, or through those marginalised?

4. What enables or hinders us from speaking up in the parish or in society?

5. How are baptised members of the parish able to participate in the mission of the Church?

6. How does prayer and liturgical celebrations, especially Sunday Mass, inspire and guide your parish?
